The 2020 General Election is approaching fast. As a voter you will want to make an informed decision about who to vote for to represent you in Parliament. The Howard League (an independent charity) can help you ask questions of the political parties on their plans for the country, and get the answers back to you in time for you to vote. Questions can only be about current political issues or party policies. If you want to communicate with an MP about personal matters or issues related to your case, then you should do this by a separate letter.
